The following information that will help you prepare for the test:

Opinion Writing

In this task you will write **what** you think about a topic – and explain **why** you think so.

Understand the topic

First of all, you have to understand the writing task's topic. Make sure you understand **what** the **topic** is. If there are any words you are not sure of – look them up in a dictionary.

Planning

Taking time to plan your composition is very important. It saves time and it helps you get to better results:

- It helps you calm down.
- It helps you keep track of the time.
- It helps you **prepare** all the elements you want to include.
- It helps you stay focused.
- It helps you **organize** your writing.
- It helps you **enrich** your composition.

Think

- What is your opinion about the topic? Decide whether you agree or disagree
- What will your essay try to prove?
- Think of at least two or three reasons to support your opinion.
- Think of examples facts to support your reasons
- Think of how to express your conclusion

For example

Many people believe that good friendship is shown in hard times. Do you agree?

My opinion:

Yes.

Reasons why:

1. A good friend supports her friend in hard times.

For example: She listens when the friend talks about her struggle. She helps her friend with what she can.

2. A good friend keeps her friend's secrets.

For example: She doesn't gossip with others about the friend's problems.

How to write

Structure of a Paragraph

A paragraph is a group of sentences about one idea. Each paragraph should be at least three (3) sentences long. The sentences should be:

The topic sentence: States your opinion or argument.

Supporting sentences: Sentences that give supporting information and examples to your opinion. Each detail in a separate sentence. Use connectors to make it into one whole cohesive idea. (for connectors, see appendix)

Concluding sentence: Summarizes your opinion about the argument and ends neatly.

Structure of Your Composition

Paragraph 1 - Introduction

Firstly, introduce the topic you are going to write about.

- Topic sentence: This is a general statement about the topic, IN YOUR OWN WORDS. DON'T just copy the topic !!
- The reader should know from the beginning what you are going to discuss.
- Second sentence: Give your opinion

Paragraph 2 - Argument 1

You need 2 different points, opinion arguments in 2 different paragraphs

- State the first main argument in paragraph 2 with a topic sentence.
- Give at least two supporting details, such as:
 - the reason you think this way
 - explanations, examples or facts to support your argument

Paragraph 3 - Argument 2

- State the second main point with a topic sentence.
- Make sure your second argument/opinion is different from the first.
- Give at least two supporting details.
- Make sure that your arguments are related to the main idea you introduced to your reader in the beginning.

Paragraph 4 - Conclusion

- Restate your main idea.
- Restate your opinion
- Leave the reader with a good impression.
- Your readers should feel that you have presented your arguments:
 - \circ Clearly
 - Persuasively
 - Grammatically correct

Your writing will be graded according to the following rubric:

Content and Organization:

- The composition is on topic.
- Information is relevant
- Content is understood
- Text is well organized

Vocabulary:

- Correct use of rich/varied words
- Appropriate use of instances of language chunks and phrases (such as phrasal verbs and collocations)
- Use of connectors

Language:

- Correct use of basic tenses and language structures
- Word order
- Pronouns
- Prepositions

Mechanics:
